English for Academic Purposes (EAP)

- Caters for students who need to enhance their English language proficiency so that they can access their curriculum effectively.

Literacy and Numeracy Flexi Groups

- Smaller class size with two teachers
- Follow same basic curriculum and use the same resources
- Additional support to help with literacy and numeracy learning

Learning Support Centre (LSC)

- Meeting support needs of students with Special Educational Needs
- MYP Curriculum is differentiated and modified where appropriate
- Small group teaching
- Additional EA and Parent Funded EA support



Support at KGV

Gifted and Talented (G&T)

- Flexi groupings and extra-curricular provision



Support at KGV

High Performing Athletes Programme (HPAP)

- Provides support for athletes to improve their sporting performance whilst maintaining their academic standards.

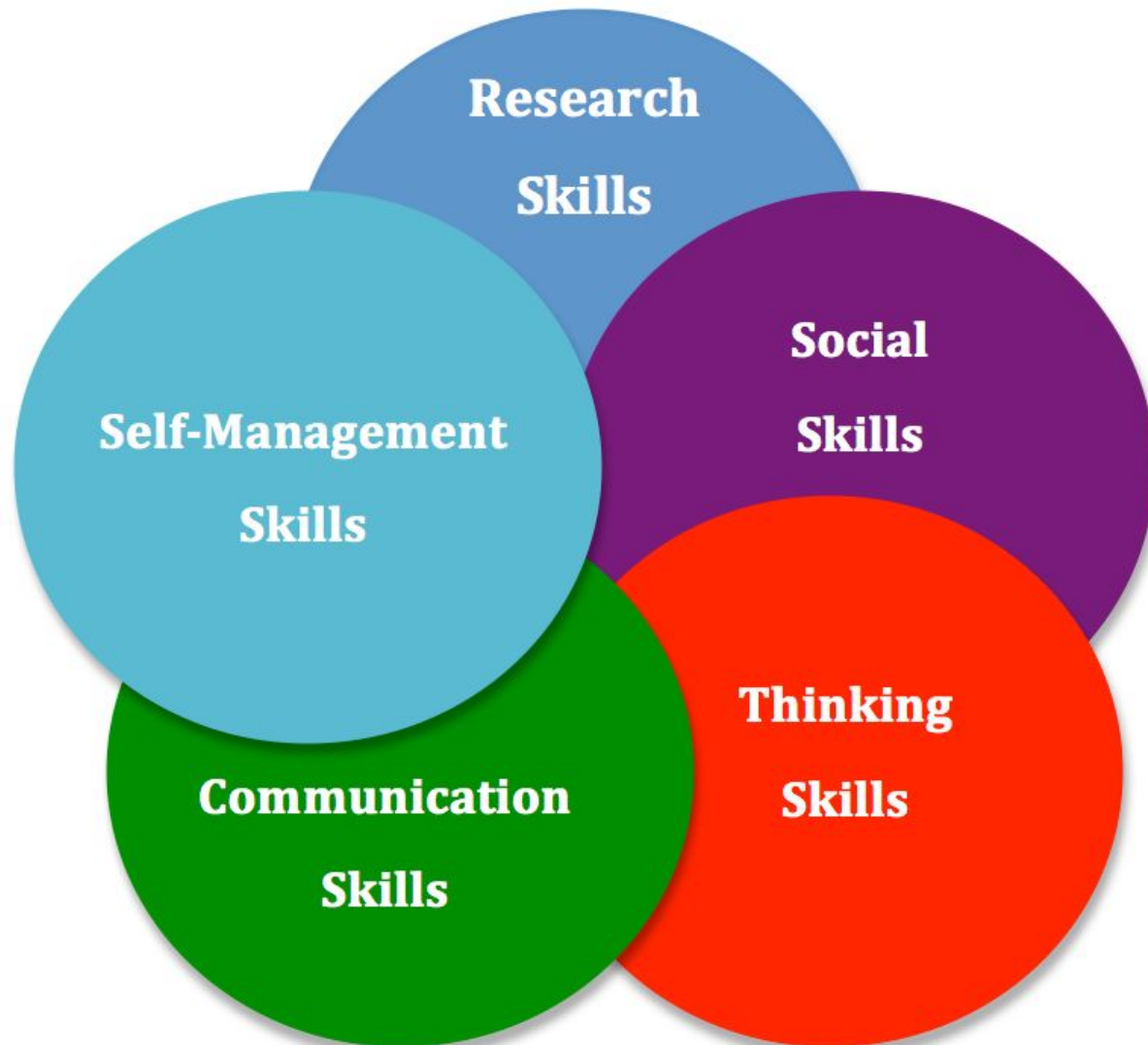
