We strongly advise against contacting other families or parents directly to discuss incidents that your children report. This approach ensures that all parties receive accurate and constructive information, preventing misunderstandings and promoting a positive environment for our children.

## Why Contact School Staff First?

Clarity and Accuracy: Teachers and school staff are present during school hours and are knowledgeable about the day's events and the context in which they occur.

Handling of Situations: Our staff is adept at managing and resolving conflicts or issues effectively and respectfully. We aim to work with the students involved first and teach them the skills needed to resolve conflicts on their own.

Confidentiality and Sensitivity: Addressing concerns through the school respects the privacy and dignity of all students and families involved.

We want to reassure you that if there is anything significant that needs to be communicated to families, we will not hesitate to reach out directly. Contact the Teacher: Reach out to your child's teacher, who can provide you with the necessary context and information.

Follow Up: If further action is needed, the teacher will speak with the appropriate children, and families as necessary, to ensure a comprehensive response.
